- Prosecco Spumanté "Apericina" (Italy)**  **£6.00/£28.00**  
 Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles with lots of fresh peach, pear and an elegant zest.
- Bouvet Cremant de Loire Blanc de Blancs (Loire, France)** **£7.00/£35.00**  
 Elegant alternative to Prosecco. Hints of pear, apples and white flowers.

## WHITE WINE

- Michel Servin Blanc (South of France)** **£4.50/£7.50/£20.00**  
 Up-front nose of citrus fruit, grassy and herbaceous blend with elderflower hints.
- Pinot Grigio, "San Giorgio" (Breganze, Italy)**   **£4.80/£7.80/£23.00**  
 Crisp white with invigorating citrus fruit. Honeysuckle meets pear drop notes for a balanced palate.
- Sauvignon Blanc "Fernlands" (Marlborough, New Zealand)** **£5.50/£9.50/£28.00**  
 Wonderful balance between tropical and herbaceous flavours. Gooseberry and pepper Mingle with mango and guava.
- Verdejo, Dominio de la Fuente, Organic (Rueda, Spain)** **£25.00**  
 Bright, pale straw yellow, with intense, fresh notes of grass, fennel and white pepper
- Mozzafiato Falanghina (Italy)**   **£27.00**  
 Light straw yellow with greenish reflections. It is fresh and fruity to the nose with notes of citrus, pineapple and white flowers.
- Picpoul de Pinet "L'abeille" (South of France)**   **£28.00**  
 A youthful white wine full of lively lemon fruit and lime zest flavours
- Albarino "El Cante" (Rias Baixas, Spain)**   **£29.00**  
 Nectarine, apricot and peach are in perfect balance with a zesty and well defined citrus backbone.
- Alvarinho 'Casal de Ventozela' (Portugal)**   **£31.00**  
 This lively yellow wine is extremely fresh with flavours of citrus and apple. Complexity and depth are added by ageing in oak barrels.
- Malagouzia "Kalgoeri" Domaine Papagiannakos (Greece)**   **£34.00**  
 Lifted peach, apricot and white blossom aromas. Broad with stone fruit characters and ripe, balancing lemon acidity. Fresh and textural with good length.
- Sarafin Chardonnay (Turkey)** **£32.00**  
 One of Turkey's best wines, a powerful Chardonnay with stone fruit and spice giving an excellent food wine.
- Sancerre, Duc Armand (Loire, France)**   **£39.00**  
 Elegant dry white wine, pale yellow colour, aromas of white flowers and green apple and refreshing citrus flavours.
