Dry Rose, Kavaklıdere, Denizli (Turkey)

The favourite rose wine of Turkey, It is produces from "Çal Karası" grapes grown in Denizli. This delicious rose wine has attractive red fruit aromas, fresh acidity and persistency of flavours.

Nicolas Rouzet, Coteaux d'Aix en Provence (France)

Bright pink in colour with a delicate balance of crisp acidity and soft, ripe summer fruit.

Château de Berne Rosé, Côtes de Provence (France)

£35.00

An attractive and delicate honeysuckle pink wine with a nose of summer fruits and tropical mango. Intense, crisp, well balanced and refreshing on the palate.

Michel Servin Rouge (South Of France)

£4.50/£7.50/£20.00

Soft, ripe and jammy blackcurrant fruit alongside a muscular texture makes this a robust, well balanced wine.

Merlot Reserva "Terra Vega" (Colchagua, Chile)

£4.80/£7.80/£23.00

The wine delivers a solid core of concentrated fruit, hinting at blackberry preserves and damson plums.

Malbec "Tierra Plata" (Mendoza, Argentina)

£5.50/£9.50/£27.00

An intense nose of plum and bramble. Fulsome on the palate, delivering a wave of ripe, fresh black fruit and mocha..

Dão, Wisdom Tree (Portugal)

£26.00

Delightfully soft and rounded, this wine is full of plum and bramble flavours with touches of herbs and a slight spiciness to the finish.

Wild Ocean Cabernet (South Africa)

£28.00

A richly-textured velvety wine with ripe plum and blackcurrant fruit aromas and a touch of vanilla oak. Soft and juicy.

Rioja Reserva, Conde De Castile (Rioja, Spain)

£30.00

A complex wine that displays a harmonious blend of dried, stewed fruits and nuances of leather, vanilla and tobacco.

Château Villegly "L'Excellence", Minervois (France)

£32.00

A silky, dry and fleshy wine offering well-marked fruit aromas, tangy notes of fruit pies, apples, cedar, with a mineral finish nuanced by crisp tannins.

Malbec, Quid Pro Quo (Mendoza, Argentina)

£33.00

Elegantly structured, rich, showing plummy fruit and hints of smoke and chocolate.

Florão Red, Quinta da Fonte Souto (Portugal)

£33.00

Aromas of red cherries fused with hints of pine forest and wet earth. The up-front fruit flavours are silky smooth, punctuated by forest fruits, clove and peppers.

Cuvee Pierre Brun, Domaine des Tourelles (Lebanon)

£34.00

Fine aromatic morello cherry and spice aromas, a dark fruit core with layered earthy spice, and balanced tannins.

Pinot Noir, Ella's Ridge (Marlborough, New Zealand)

£36.00

Bright and fresh with varietal ripe cherry aromas, with vibrant flavours of red berries and spice.

Cabernet Sauvignon Blend "Signium" (Turkey)

£39.00

A powerful blend with ripe cherry and prune fruit backed up with hints of vanilla and roasted almond. Spicy aromas and an abundance of flavour giving a well structured wine.

Les Terrasses de Saint Christophe, Saint-Émilion Grand Cru (Bordeaux, France)

£44.00

Complex dark fruit aromas overlayed with a herbaceous and savoury background. Black plums and cherries dominate the medium bodied palate with hints of cocoa on the finish.
