Crisp white with invigorating citrus fruit. Honeysuckle meets pear drop notes for a balanced palate.	
Sauvignon Blanc "Castaway Bay" (South Africa)	6.50 / 10.50 / 31.00
A wonderful mix of leafy aromas and citrus on the nose with lively green apple on the pallet.	
Verdejo, Dominio de la Fuente, Organic (Rueda, Spain)	32.00
Bright, pale straw yellow, with intense, fresh notes of grass, fennel and white pepper	
Mozzafiato Falanghina (Italy)	33.00
Light straw yellow with greenish reflections. It is fresh and fruity to the nose with notes of citrus, pineapple and white flowers.	
Picpoul de Pinet "d'Isabelle" (South of France)	36.00
A youthful white wine full of lively lemon fruit and lime zest flavours	
Albariño "El Cante" (Rias Baixas, Spain)	37.00
Nectarine, apricot & peach are in perfect balance with zesty and well defined citrus notes.	
Alvarinho 'Casal de Ventozela' (Portugal)	37.00
This lively yellow wine is extremely fresh with flavours of citrus and apple.	
Sauvignon Blanc "Fernlands" (Marlborough, New Zealand)	38.00
Herbal notes and exotic hints of guava and elderflower on the nose, and flavours of gooseberry, citrus and ripe melons.	
Malagouzia "Kalgoeri" Domaine Papagiannakos (Greece) 	-----
Lifted peach, apricot and white blossom aromas. Broad with stone fruit characters and ripe, balancing lemon acidity. Fresh and textural with good length.	
Sarafi Chardonnay (Turkey)	39.00
One of Turkey's best wines, a powerful Chardonnay with stone fruit and spice giving an excellent food wine.	
Sancerre, Duc Armand (Loire, France)	49.00
Elegant dry white wine, pale yellow colour, aromas of white flowers and green apple.	
Chablis 1er Cru Fourchaume, Domaine Chatelain	68.00
On the nose, it emits delicate hints of almond, butter and licorice. The palate is round and buttery with flavours of citrus, marmalade and toasted almond. and refreshing citrus flavours.

Dry Rose, Kavaklidere, Denizli (Turkey)

The favourite rose wine of Turkey, It is produces from "Çal Karası" grapes grown in Denizli. This delicious rose wine has attractive red fruit aromas, fresh acidity and persistency of flavours.

Michel Servin Rouge (South Of France)

Soft, ripe and jammy blackcurrant fruit alongside a muscular texture makes this a robust, well balanced wine.

Merlot Reserva "Terra Vega" (Colchagua, Chile)

The wine delivers a solid core of concentrated fruit, hinting at blackberry preserves and damson plums.

An intense nose of plum and bramble. Fulsome on the palate, delivering a wave of ripe, fresh black fruit and mocha..

Delightfully soft and rounded, this wine is full of plum and bramble flavours with touches of herbs and a slight spiciness to the finish.

Wild Ocean Cabernet (South Africa)

A richly-textured velvety wine with ripe plum and blackcurrant fruit aromas and a touch of vanilla oak. Soft and juicy.

Rioja Reserva, Conde De Castile (Rioja, Spain)

A complex wine that displays a harmonious blend of dried, stewed fruits and nuances of leather, vanilla and tobacco.

Cabernet Sauvignon Gran Reserva, Terra Vega (Chile)

The palate is elegant, with round tannins and a medium volume, highlighted by its fruit notes and those of tobacco and caramel vanilla and tobacco.

Malbec, Quid Pro Quo (Mendoza, Argentina)

Elegantly structured, rich, showing plummy fruit and hints of smoke and chocolate.

Cuvee Pierre Brun, Domaine des Tourelles (Lebanon)

Fine aromatic morello cherry and spice aromas, a dark fruit core with layered earthy spice, and balanced tannins.

Pinot Noir, Ella's Ridge (Marlborough, New Zealand)

Bright and fresh with varietal ripe cherry aromas, with vibrant flavours of red berries and spice.

Cabernet Sauvignon Blend "Signium" (Turkey)

A powerful blend with ripe cherry and prune fruit backed up with hints of vanilla and roasted almond. Spicy aromas and an abundance of flavour giving a well structured wine.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Clefs du Cellier (Rhône, France)

A garnet-red wine with aromas of fresh red fruits, spices and a hint of chocolate. The palate is silky smooth with a powerful fruit intensity and wonderful complexity.

A medium-bodied claret, with a pleasantly spicy and mature nose, with hints of leather and clove against a backdrop of bramble and dried prune fruit.
